- Current prescription of eye glasses or contacts (contact box);
- If you are being referred by another ophthalmologist, please bring medical records;

New patient appointments may take approximately 2 hours. As part of a thorough new patient exam, your eyes may be dilated. Dilation typically remains for 4-6 hours after your examination. During this time, your near vision will be compromised and you will experience light sensitivity. Therefore, before leaving our facilities, we will provide you with disposable sunglasses. Most people are able to drive following dilation, but you may want to bring a driver if you have experienced problems driving in the past, or if your eyes have never been dilated.

If your insurance requires you to have a referral from your Primary Care Physician, please call their office to obtain your referral prior to your appointment. Failure to obtain a referral could delay your appointment. All co-payments and any additional services not covered will be collected at the time of your appointment. Please call your insurance company should you have any questions regarding coverage. You will be held responsible for any fees not covered by your insurance.

Please note: For all patients under the age of 18, a parent or legal guardian must accompany him or her.

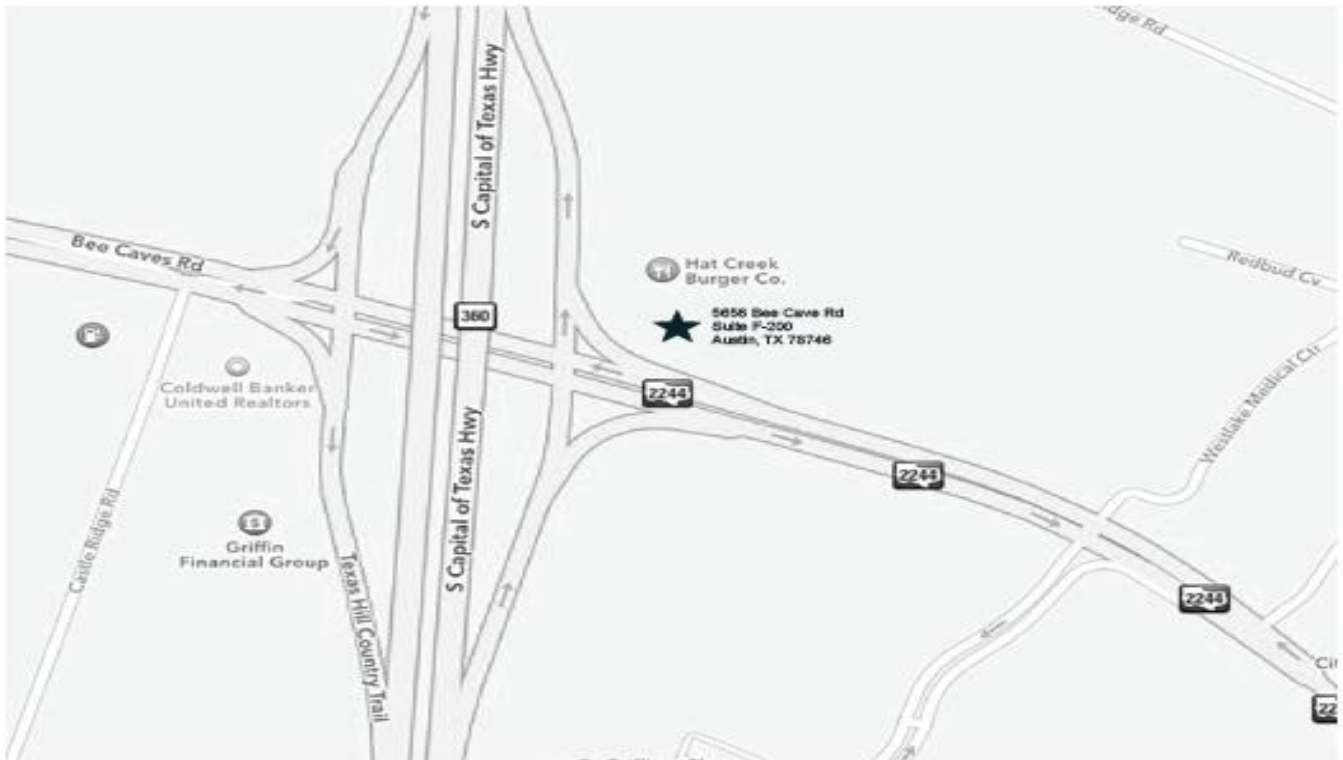
